Congregate Meal Program

Population(s) Served: n/a

The Congregate Meal Program is an on-going program that provides hot, fresh cooked meals daily to seniors age 60+, in a restaurant style setting. The program is designed to help seniors win their battle against food insecurity, loneliness and isolation. The meals provided are substantial, nutritious, and meet strict dietary guidelines established by the County of San Diego Aging and Independence Services (AIS) who sponsor the program, conduct stringent oversight, and provide approx. onethird of the funding. In addition to providing wholesome meals, the program provides an environment to encourage socialization to reduce issues of depression caused by isolation. Many seniors desire to maintain their independence and remain in their homes rather than live out their years in a care facility. However, care must be taken that independence doesn't result in isolation which the health industry has reported can be as deadly as smoking and obesity, increasing odds of mortality by 30%.



-GuideStar acquires all IRS data directly from the Internal Revenue Service.

-The <u>IRS Internal Revenue Bulletin</u> (IRB) lists changes in charitable status since the last Publication 78 release. Between the release of IRS Publication 78 and the subsequent IRS Internal Revenue Bulletin, the IRB date will reflect the most recent release date of IRS Publication 78.

-The IRS Business Master File lists approximately 1.7 million nonprofits registered with the IRS as tax-exempt organizations. -The <u>IRS Automatic Revocation of Exemption List</u> contains organizations that have had their federal tax-exempt status automatically revoked for failing to file an annual return or notice with the IRS for three consecutive years

-The Foundation Status Code is a value derived by mapping the codes found on the <u>990PF filing instructions</u> to the corresponding codes in the IRS BMF. Note that not all codes are able to be mapped due to insufficient data.

-The Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) <u>Specially Designated Nationals (SDN) list</u> organizations that are owned or controlled by targeted individuals, groups, and entities, such as terrorists or narcotics traffickers. Their assets are blocked and U.S. persons are generally prohibited from dealing with them.
